



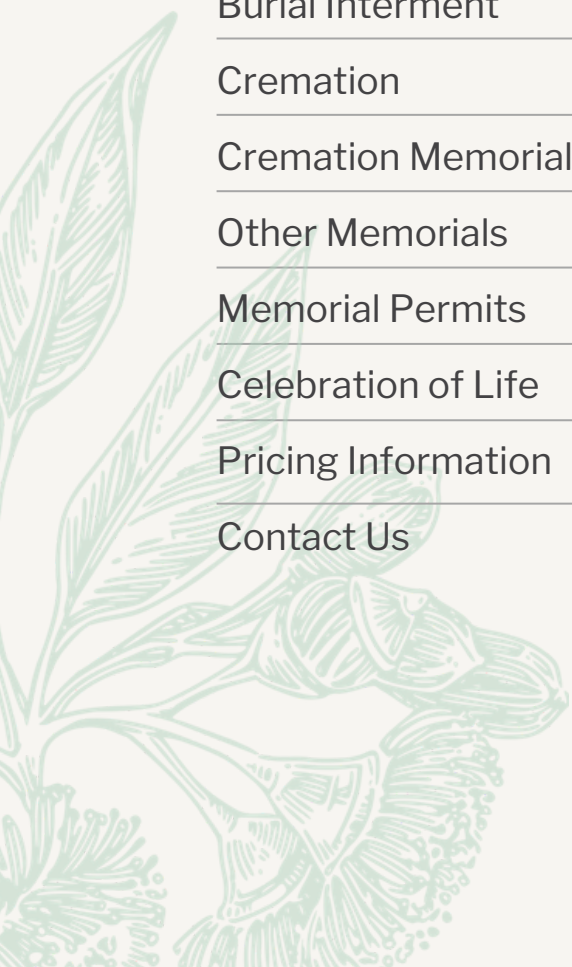

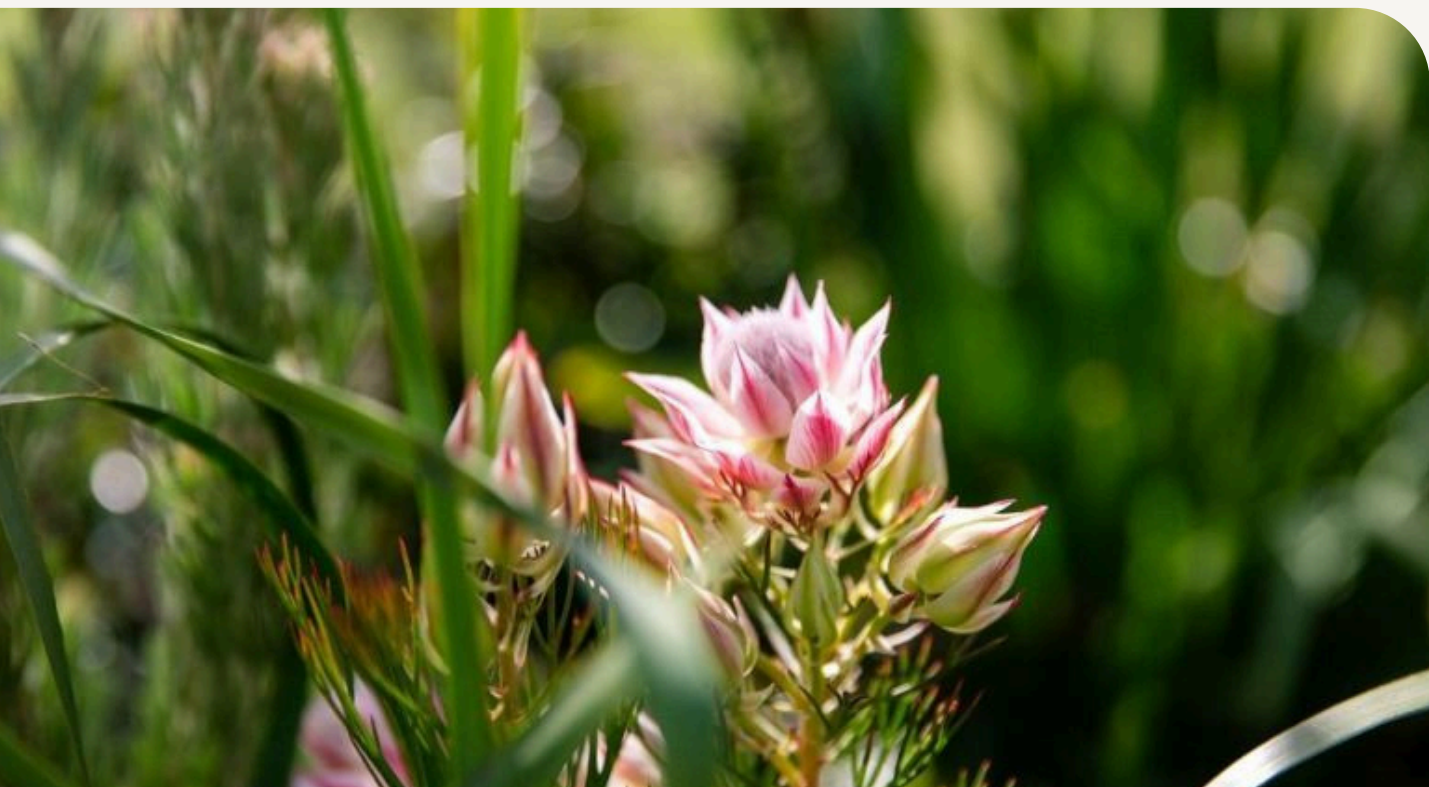

# Pricing Information

All prices are gazetted fees in accordance with the *Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2003 (Vic) (Act)*.

This price list is accurate as of 2 July 2026. Please note this list may be updated from time to time. Visit [www.gct.net.au](http://www.gct.net.au) to download the most recent version.

Right of interment fees (i.e. products) and stonemasonry permit fees are exempt from GST as per Division 81 of the *Goods and Services Tax Act 1999*.

## Availability of Products

Each right of interment is subject to availability at the cemetery or memorial park. Not all products are available at all locations. Please check the website or confirm with our Client Services team to ensure availability prior to making arrangements.

## Payment Requirements

We accept payment by cash, cheque, BPAY, and credit card.

A right of interment (ROI) can only be granted once the ROI fee has been paid in full. Interment and cremation fees are required to be paid in full prior to the date of the interment/cremation, unless paid by a funeral director under agreed settlement terms.

## Fee Waiver or Reduction

In accordance with section 44 of the Act, fees must not be waived or reduced except on grounds of extreme hardship or other special circumstances. Please speak to our Client Services team if you have any questions.

## Refunds

Where a refund relates to a pre-purchased grave or memorial position (right of interment), the value of the refund is calculated in accordance with section 82(2) of the Act:

*(a) the cemetery trust must pay to the holder a refund based on the current cemetery trust fee payable for the same type of right of interment less the relevant cemetery trust fee for administration and any maintenance costs.*

The administration fees (surrender right of interment and cancellation prepaid cremation) are gazetted in accordance with the Act.

## Weighted Scale for Surrender of a Right of Interment

The weighted scale for maintenance costs is a sliding scale set by the Department of Health, with year one commencing from the date of granting the right of interment. The scale is expressed as a percentage (%) of the current fee, with the percentage value increasing each year on the anniversary date of the granting of the right of interment.



# Pricing Information

## How We are Obligated to Set Service Fees and Product Prices

All prices in this brochure are set in accordance with requirements under the Act. In setting fees, we must have regard to the following legislative requirements in accordance with section 39(2) of the Act:

In fixing fees and charges under this section, a cemetery trust must have regard to:

- *the costs of operating and managing the public cemetery; and*
- *the fees and charges guidelines, if any; and*
- *the need to provide for the maintenance of the public cemetery in perpetuity.*

## Maintenance of Memorials

The right of interment holder is responsible for maintaining any memorial established in a safe and proper condition.

We are empowered through the Act to issue directions in relation to the maintenance of memorials and can take action to render a memorial safe, if necessary. We may seek consent of the Department of Health to repair, take down, or dispose of a memorial and may seek recovery of associated costs and expenses from the right of interment holder.
